



USDA REDLG

ACEC (\$1.5 million), along with MiEnergy Cooperative (\$1.86 million) and Dairyland Power Cooperative (\$2,500 and a \$2,500 match from CoBank), utilized the USDA's Rural Economic Development Loan (REDLG) program to assist the Sunflower Child Development Center with funds for construction of a new childcare facility.
