

HAUSCHILD SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION RULES

- 1. Applicant must be a current graduating high school senior.
- 2. Applicant's parents or legal guardians are not required to be ACEC members but must reside within the outer boundaries of the Cooperative's service territory.
- 3. Applicant must be entering a course of study related to work within the electric field. The Cooperative will give preference to applicants whose education will qualify them for work as electricians, electric line workers, electrical engineers, etc., over applicants pursuing an education more applicable to the repair of electrical appliances or computers.
- 4. Applicants are not allowed to use AI to compose their essay on why they are seeking this scholarship. All essays will be run through a scanner to ensure they are original. Any entirely AI-generated essays will be disqualified.
- 5. Applicant must complete required scholarship application forms and meet filing deadlines.
- 6. Allamakee-Clayton Electric Cooperative may ask the applicant to appear for a personal interview with the scholarship committee.
- 7. Applicants selected as Hauschild Memorial Scholarship winners will receive a certificate designating the award. In addition, scholarship funds will be paid directly to the educational institution attended by the scholarship winner(s) upon receiving a grade transcript or other notice of adequate completion of first semester classes and enrollment for the second semester.
- 8. Should an applicant selected as a winner fail to meet the guidelines established above within two years of the date of the award, the scholarship shall become void. The winner shall not be entitled to collect the Hauschild Memorial Scholarship or any portion thereof.
